

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT SEPT. 9, 2008

It gives me great pleasure to announce that there will be a victory parade for Stony Point's very own New York State 10 year old Little League All Star Champions. The victory parade will begin at 3PM at Town Hall on Sunday September 28th and end with a reception at the North Rockland Social Club at 4 PM. Congratulations to the players, coaches and families on this wonderful event.

At a meeting called by the NYSDOT today, we were informed that plans are being formulated to close the Farley Bridge in the spring of 2009 for the purposes of demolition. The DOT is fast tracking this project and foresees a new bridge being in place by the end of December 2009. At that meeting I requested that the DOT make themselves available to the public to convey information and answer questions and concerns by Stony Point residents. The NYSDOT has accepted my invitation to that meeting. The October 14th Stony Point Town Board Meeting will be held at the Farley Middle School starting at 7PM. I want to thank in advance the North Rockland School District for their cooperation and to the NYS DOT in setting up this meeting. The elected officials of Stony Point wish to be as open and transparent as possible in order to keep the public informed of such an important project.
