

## **NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that sealed proposals will be received by the Town of Stony Point, New York on or before June 30, 2010 at 10:00 A.M., for the furnishing of all labor and material, tools and equipment required for the satisfactory completion of the Project entitled:

### **IMPROVEMENTS TO "THE CLIFFS" STORM SEWER SYSTEM TOWN OF STONY POINT, ROCKLAND COUNTY, NEW YORK**

The Project work will consist of supplying all labor and equipment, including crushed stone backfill, surface restoration, and disposal of deleterious materials including portions of existing storm sewer piping and structures in order to improve the operation of the existing storm sewer.

The Project consists of the construction of an outlet control structure on the existing 18" RCP outfall pipe located in the existing stormwater detention basin located behind property known as SBL 14.04-4-58. In addition, the existing 36" HDPE storm sewer pipe that was placed over the existing Algonquin gas transmission mains has collapsed in several sections and must be replaced. The storm sewer line that runs across Pierce Drive downstream of the Algonquin Gas crossing needs to be replaced with new 36" HDPE pipe because the existing 36" RCP pipe entering the downstream drainage structure is 0.20' below the outlet pipe from the same structure. Lastly, the final run of pipe from the system (42" RCP pipe), located in the rear of property known as SBL 14.04-4-3 needs to be replaced with 42" HDPE pipe to increase flow capacity and to restore pipe alignment. The manhole at this junction also needs to have an invert constructed inside of it. The Town will be supplying a new roof slab and manhole cover that the Contractor will install at the Contractor's expense.

The successful bidder will be responsible for all means and methods of construction, including but not limited to trench dewatering and by-pass pumping. The existing storm sewer system always has a steady flow of water in it from the aforementioned detention basin.

The selected Contractor will be required to pick-up pre-purchased piping and structures at the Town's Highway Department Yard on Rose Street, Stony Point, New York and incorporate these items into the Project. The Contractor shall include in his/her bid the costs associated with transporting the Project materials from the Town's Highway Department Yard to the site in the overall cost of the Project.

The Project plans provide detailed information relative to the construction of the improvements as well as appropriate construction specifications. The final run of pipe at the rear of property known as SBL 14.04-4-3 does not have an associated profile or plan since the new pipe will be placed at the same pipe slope and inverts as the existing 42" RCP pipe.

### **PRE-BID MEETING**

There will be a mandatory Pre-Bid meeting to go over the Project requirements on Thursday, June 24, 2010 at 10:00 AM. All interested Bidders shall meet for this

mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting at the Town Clerk's Office, 74 East Main Street, Stony Point, New York at 10:00 AM on June 24, 2010.

PREVAILING WAGE

Bidders' shall be aware that this Project is a Public Works Project funded by public funds. As such, all employees working on the Project shall be paid the prevailing wage rate for their specific job title/duties. The successful bidder will be required to submit certified payrolls attesting to the compliance with this item.

Bid documents will be available commencing June 18, 2010 from the Stony Point Town Clerk, 74 East Main St, Stony Point, New York 10980. All bids must be in the hands of the Town Clerk, Stony Point, New York no later than 10:00 A.M. on June 30, 2010. Copies of the Contract Documents may be examined and obtained at the Office of the Town Clerk during usual business hours. Contact person – Town Engineer, Kevin P. Maher at 845-786-2716 (ext. 105).

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check, or bid bond executed by a surety company, in the amount of \$5,000, conditioned that if the proposal is accepted, the bidder will enter into a contract for the work, and that he or she will execute such further security as is required for the faithful performance of the Contract. All bids must meet the requirements of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and all other applicable Federal, State and local statutes.

The proposals will be opened and read aloud by the Town Clerk of the Town of Stony Point on June 30, 2010, at 10:30 A.M at Town Hall.

The lowest qualified bidder meeting the requirements of the Contract Documents will be awarded the bid. The Town Board reserves the right to accept or reject any or all portions of the proposal, and to re-advertise for same, should the best interest of the Town thereby be promoted. The Town also reserves the right to reject any proposal that is informal, or waive any informality in the bidding document.
