Soon the Fall leaf season will be upon us, and although the leaves are very colorful to look at while they are on the tree's, once they fall, they take a lot of effort to clean up. By doing your part, you can help the Highway Department with our Annual Leaf Clean Up.

We ask that you DO NOT rake the leaves into the streets. This causes the leaves to back up the drainage systems which can lead to various other problems. Instead, please rake up your leaves and place them into biodegradable bags and place at the curb of your yard for pick up. The bags are supplied by Town and be picked up at the Highway Department garage beginning in Mid-September. Your Highway Department will begin collecting the bags of leaves every Friday on a weekly basis until Mid-Fall when we will begin to collect on the bags on a daily basis.
