## Camp safety rules

### Camp

**Watch out for the children!!**

**Please Park in the designated area.**

**Sign out-show identification and sign out in the office.**

Children leaving early or leaving with a non-relative must have a note from a parent or guardian-**no**

**phone calls please!**

All immunizations must be up-to-date!

Mark your child's belongings.

Children should know where they live and their phone number!

Minimum age-Completed 1<sup>st</sup>. grade or 7 years of age- no exceptions!

You **must** be a Town of Stony Point resident. Bus safety is very important! **Appropriate behavior on a bus is mandatory!**

**Camp personnel cannot administer medications!**

## Pool rules

All children will be given a swimming test.

Children will be assigned to certain areas of the pool based upon ability.

Children must obey "**Rules of the Pool**"

Children must have a towel and an appropriate bathing suit.

Children must wear sneakers or sandals when not swimming.

# Please Read To Your Child

## Lost Camper Plan

### At Camp

The camper is to report to the First Aid Station/  
Camp Office.

The child will then be returned to his/her group.

### Off site/ Field Trip

The children will first be assigned a buddy.

group leader paged.

Group leader will report a child missing to the  
proper authorities (15 minutes).

### Off Limits

Chemical area around the

fence)

The pond, by the playing  
field, absolutely off  
limits.

The wooded area  
surrounding the playing  
field and blacktop is off  
limits.

## Lightning/Thunderstorm Plan

### At Camp

The emergency horn will be sounded.

Campers will line up as a group-counselors will bring  
the children to the pavilion.

Children will be instructed to seek shelter in the  
bldg.

Counselors will bring their cars to the black top and  
put remaining children in their cars.

Call the bus company to transport children to  
Farley Middle School.

### Off Site/Field Trip

Counselors are to seek protective shelter indoors  
as quickly as possible.
